Costs associated with earning the 36 credits required to complete the Master of Science in Seed Technology and Business are approximately \$29,000*. Graduate certificates are approximately \$13,000* depending on your course of study. The STB tuition rate follows that of the ISU MBA program and is subject to change. FAQ's

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

If you are a professional working in the seed sector, the **Graduate Program in Seed Technology and Business (STB)** has been designed specifically with your needs in mind. The STB program is completely online and offers an interdisciplinary Master of Science degree that provides you with current seed science and technology instruction along with essential courses in business management in a rigorous, integrated curriculum. The program also offers Graduate Certificates focusing on seed science and technology and seed business management. **Find out more: seedgrad.iastate.edu**

? What is required for admission to the STB program?

Whether seeking the Master of Science degree or a graduate certificate, you must complete the Iowa State University admission process. You may submit the following admission requirements online at admissions.iastate.edu:

- Admission application and fee. (Current application fee is \$60/domestic and \$100/international, non-refundable)
- Provide transcripts as evidence of a bachelor's degree or higher in a business or agriculture-related program of study from a regionally accredited institution. (Other majors or areas of concentration will be considered)
- If English is not your native language, you will be required to submit evidence of English proficiency. (TOEFL - iBT of 79 or better, IELTS of 6.5 or better)
- An additional English proficiency evaluation may be required upon admission.
- Three letters of recommendation from individuals who can attest to your potential for graduate study.
- Personal essay addressing your academic and career goals and how a degree or certificate in Seed Technology and Business at Iowa State University will help you reach those goals.
- Professional resume.
- **Not Required:** GRE or GMAT standardized tests are not required, but may be submitted as evidence of potential success as a graduate student.
- There is no residency requirement, and international students are encouraged to apply.

? Can I complete the STB program at my own pace?

The Master of Science degree in Seed Technology and Business is a 36 credit–36 month course of study, paced for the working professional. We understand that career and family demands can sometimes cause delays in the completion of the program. Under the Iowa State University regulations, a graduate student may have up to eight years to complete their MS degree. This allows our STB students flexibility in their schedules to accommodate unforeseen circumstances.

? What are the tuition and fees for the STB program?

The STB graduate program follows the Iowa State University Master of Business Administration (MBA) rate of tuition which is \$695/credit hour. STB students should also consider the cost of text books and a university required technology fee of approximately \$71.00. (Tuition and fees are subject to change).

? What is the course curriculum for the STB program?

The STB program courses are delivered completely online through the CANVAS Learning Management System. They are taught by the same instructors as our courses on the Iowa State University campus.
